

Applications open for a Grant from the Marcia Dugan Memorial Fund for the 2016 HLAA/IFHOH Congress

The Board of IFHOH is accepting applications for a grant from the Marcia Dugan Memorial Fund for partial coverage of expenses for a hard of hearing person to attend 2016 IFHOH Congress and BGM in Washington, D.C, USA June 23-25, 2016.

Who is eligible as a candidate?

Any hard of hearing person, regardless of age, who demonstrates an interest in working with hard of hearing people and who are currently involved with hearing loss issues. Preference will be given to individuals from IFHOH member countries as well as to an individual from a developing country.

The applicant must have demonstrated an interest in remaining actively involved with hearing loss issues and must have indicated that a grant would enable his/her attendance at the IFHOH Congress and BGM. A short presentation is expected to be given at the IFHOH BGM. An article from the candidate is expected following the Congress and BGM. Willingness to have his or her name publicized in receiving the award will be a condition. Note: the candidate must have eligibility for a Visa if applicable.

The selection of the fellowship recipient will be announced by end of February, 2016.
